

# Latino Chamber Development Corporation - Foundation Latino Lifetime Achievement Award Nomination

The Latino Chamber Foundation Board of Directors is pleased to announce the Latino Lifetime Achievement Nomination process for 2014. The Latino Lifetime Achievement Award is awarded annually to deserving individuals who have exhibited continuous, selfless contributions to the Hispanic community of Pueblo in any one or more of the following areas: business, politics, social, education, humanitarian or other philanthropic activities.

### **Criteria for Selection:**

- 1. The person(s) selected can be either a present or past member of the Latino Chamber of Commerce of Pueblo, or someone who has been a staunch supporter of The Latino Chamber of Commerce of Pueblo.
- 2. The person(s) selected can be a living person or someone can be selected and honored posthumously.
- 3. The person(s) selected does not have to be a present resident of Pueblo; however, the contributions to the Hispanic Community should be primarily in the Pueblo Community and must be evident and documented.

#### **Selection:**

- 1. Nomination applications (see next page) for the Lifetime Achievement Award will be maintained at the Latino Chamber of Commerce of Pueblo, 215 S. Victoria Avenue, Pueblo, CO 81003.
- 2. Nominations for the Award must be submitted by 5:00 pm Wednesday, July 9, 2014.
- 3. Selection of the individual(s) from the nomination submitted will ultimately be made by the Past President's Council of the LCDC Foundation at the first meeting of the Board following the nomination presentations by the Special Events Committee.
- 4. The person(s) selected by the LCDC Foundation Board will be honored at the luncheon meeting of the 16th of September of each year, if the 16<sup>th</sup> of said month falls on a holiday, Saturday, or Sunday, the award luncheon may be moved to another date as close to the 16<sup>th</sup> of September. The Luncheon date for 2014 Friday, September 19<sup>th</sup> and will be held at Colorado State University Pueblo, Occhiato Ballroom.
- 5. The honoree(s) should be present to accept the award, or if deceased, a spouse or other close relative should be present to accept the award.
- 6. The person nominating the honoree(s) should be present at the awards dinner to read the nomination speech or have someone from the LCDC Board read the nomination speech.
- 7. Any nominee(s) for the award who is not selected in any one year may be considered for nomination in subsequent years based on the same nomination form.
